Princess Margaret Cancer Centre ranks among the top ten oncology hospitals globally, as Canada's number one oncology hospital, and is the largest integrated cancer research, teaching, and treatment centre in Canada.

Founded as the Ontario Cancer Institute in 1952 by the Ontario government, the institute was officially opened in 1958 by Her Royal Highness the Princess Margaret and was re-named Princess Margaret Hospital. In 2012, and approved by Queen Elizabeth II, Princess Margaret Hospital was formally renamed the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre to better reflect its status as one of the top comprehensive cancer treatment and research facilities in the world.

In 1998, the Princess Margaret Hospital became part of the University Health Network (UHN), a public research and teaching hospital network, affiliated with the Temerty Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto. Today UHN is comprised of Toronto General Hospital, Toronto Western Hospital, Princess Margaret Cancer Centre, West Park Healthcare Centre, the Toronto Rehabilitation Institute, The Michener Institute, a post-secondary institution granting diplomas and certificates in health sciences and leadership, and is now the largest health research organization in Canada, ranking first in the country for total research funding.

The Princess Margaret Cancer Clinical Research Unit (CCRU) is one of the largest clinical research centres in the UHN network, and is dedicated to improving treatment of cancer, providing leadership, oversight, and infrastructure for researchers within the CCRU. Every year Princess Margaret initiates upwards of 170 new clinical trials – and at any one time has over 500 trials underway.



The CCRU includes internationally recognized researchers, cutting-edge research infrastructure, and focuses on cancer research across various fields including genomics, informatics, molecular biology, signalling, structural biology, health services, and biophysics.
